Asian Cultural Council Fellowship Application for US and intra-Asia cultural exchange

Application Deadline: 1 p.m., November 16, 2018 (Hong Kong Time)

The Asian Cultural Council (ACC) has opened its applications for fellowships to be awarded in 2019 and invites arts professionals in China, Hong Kong, and Macau, to apply for cultural exchange fellowships to support specialized arts and humanities related exploration, study and research that involve international travel and cultural exchange, either between Asia and the U.S. or across regions in Asia.

The ACC program covers the visual and performing arts, both contemporary and traditional. Fields of awards include archeology, architecture, art history, arts administration, arts criticism, conservation, crafts, curation, dance, ethnomusicology, film and video, museum studies, music, photography, theater and visual art.

Application Procedures

Final decisions will be made by the Council in May 2019, and applicants will be notified of their application results thereafter.
