QIAN Ning's (ACC 2024)
Fellowship Experience
in Thailand

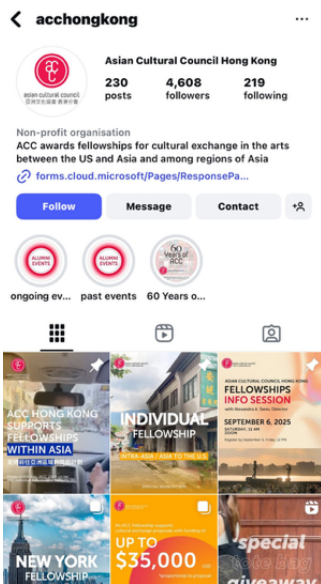
QIAN Ning, a filmmaker from Zhejiang, Mainland China, received an ACC Individual Fellowship in 2024.

He spent three months in Thailand researching temple culture and spirit mediumship, how deity-related beliefs influence contemporary life. He also compared the concept of intermediaries between deities and humans, as understood in Mainland China and Thailand.

“Spiritual traditions across the world may be rooted in different contexts but still reflect similar human longings and emotional truths,” says Qian. To explore commonalities between deity-related cultures across regions, Qian visited several temples, including Wat Phra Mahathat Woramahawihan in Thammarat, as well as Wat Yai Chai Mongkhon, Wat Ratchaburana, Wat Phukhao Thong, and Wat Chaiwatthanaram in Ayutthaya. He also participated in meditation retreats in Chiang Mai and Bangkok, which he says brought him “a sense of inner clarity and emotional cleansing.” ...
